A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to remedial plans issued by the State Board of Dental
- 3 Examiners to address complaints against dentists and dental
- 4 hygienists.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 263.0077, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (f-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (d) The board may not issue a remedial plan to resolve a
- 10 complaint against a license holder if the license holder has
- 11 entered into a remedial plan with the board in the preceding five
- 12 years [previously entered into a remedial plan with the board for
- 13 the resolution of a different complaint filed under this subtitle].
- 14 (f-1) On or after the fifth anniversary of the date a
- 15 remedial plan is issued under this section, the board may remove
- 16 from the board's public Internet website any public information
- 17 regarding the dentist or dental hygienist with respect to the plan
- 18 and the complaint resolved by the plan, unless:
- 19 (1) the complaint was related to the delivery of
- 20 <u>health care; or</u>
- 21 (2) more than one remedial plan has been issued to
- 22 resolve complaints alleging the same violation by the dentist or
- 23 dental hygienist, including a complaint not related to the delivery
- 24 of health care.

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- 1 SECTION 2. Section 263.0077, Occupations Code, as amended
- 2 by this Act, applies to a remedial plan issued by the State Board of
- 3 Dental Examiners on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 4 remedial plan issued before that date is governed by the law in
- 5 effect on the date the plan was issued, and the former law is
- 6 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
