5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 5.0622 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.0622. ADDITIONAL APPLICABILITY: CERTAIN COUNTIES.
8	(a) This section applies only to a county with a population of less
9	than 50,000 that is located:
10	(1) in a metropolitan area as defined by the federal
11	Office of Management and Budget with a population of more than 2
12	million; and
13	(2) adjacent to a county located in a different
14	metropolitan area as defined by the federal Office of Management
15	and Budget with a population of more than 2 million.
16	(b) The commissioners court of a county may adopt an order
17	requiring an executory contract for the conveyance of land
18	measuring 20 acres or less used or to be used as a residence located
19	in the county to be subject to this subchapter. The order must
20	specify a method for determining whether the land is used or to be
21	used as a residence.
22	(c) The order may not include an executory contract for the
23	conveyance of land:
24	(1) described by Section 5.062(d); or

1 (2) that is to be used primarily for agricultural use, as defined by Section 1-d, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, or for 2 farm, ranch, wildlife management, or timber production use within 3 the meaning of Section 1-d-1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, and 4 5 for which no part of the land is to be used as a residence. (d) If a tract described by Subsection (c)(2) ceases to be 6 7 used primarily for agricultural use or for farm, ranch, wildlife management, or timber production use, or any part of the land is 8 used as a residence, the executory contract for the conveyance of 9

10 the land may be included in an order authorized by this section.

SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Property Code, is amended by adding Section 5.087 to read as follows:

13 <u>Sec. 5.087. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS: CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a)</u>
14 <u>This section applies only to a county adopting an order under</u>
15 <u>Section 5.0622.</u>

16 (b) The commissioners court may not modify the provisions of 17 this subchapter except the commissioners court may provide in the 18 order that:

19 (1) an executory contract to which the order applies 20 may not be used to purchase land unless the land meets a minimum 21 frontage requirement on a public road or a private road as specified 22 in the order; and

23 (2) the conversion authorized by Section 5.081 is 24 required to occur not later than three years after the date the 25 executory contract is entered into.

26 SECTION 3. Sections 5.0622 and 5.087, Property Code, as 27 added by this Act, apply only to an executory contract entered into
