| 9 | HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE. (a) The statewide behavioral health |
| 10 | coordinating council established under Subchapter M-1, under the |
| 11 | direction of the commission, shall develop and the commission shall |
| 12 | implement a comprehensive plan to increase and improve the |
| 13 | workforce in this state to serve persons with mental health and |
| 14 | substance use issues. In developing the plan, the council shall |
| 15 | analyze and consider available studies, reports, and |
| 16 | recommendations regarding that segment of the workforce in this |
| 17 | state or elsewhere. |
| 18 | (b) The plan must include: |
| 19 | (1) a strategy and timeline for implementing the plan, |
| 20 | including short-term, medium-term, and long-term goals; |
| 21 | (2) a system for monitoring the implementation of the |
| 22 | plan; and |
| 23 | (3) a method for evaluating the outcomes of the plan. |
| 24 | SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2022, the statewide |

- 1 behavioral health coordinating council shall develop and the Health
- 2 and Human Services Commission shall begin implementing the plan
- 3 required under Section 531.02254, Government Code, as added by this
- 4 Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. The statewide behavioral health coordinating
- 6 council and the Health and Human Services Commission are required
- 7 to implement a provision of this Act only if the legislature
- 8 appropriates money to the commission specifically for that purpose.
- 9 If the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
- 10 purpose, the council and the commission may, but are not required
- 11 to, implement the provision using other appropriations made to the
- 12 commission that are available for that purpose.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
