A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the numbering and signing of ballots by early voting
- 3 clerks and deputy early voting clerks.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 85.0311, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 85.0311. <u>DEPUTY</u> EARLY VOTING CLERK TO SIGN BALLOTS.
- 8 (a) The <u>deputy</u> early voting clerk's <u>signature or</u> initials shall be
- 9 placed on the back of each ballot to be used at the polling place
- 10 where the deputy early voting clerk accepts voters voting by
- 11 personal appearance.
- 12 (b) The <u>deputy</u> early voting clerk <u>at a polling place</u> shall
- 13 enter the signature or initials of the deputy early voting clerk on
- 14 each ballot [or a deputy early voting clerk shall stamp a facsimile
- 15 of the initials on each ballot].
- 16 (c) The signing of ballots under this section need not be
- 17 completed before the polls open, but an unsigned ballot may not be
- 18 made available for selection by a voter.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 122.001, Election Code, is amended by
- 20 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsections (f), (g), and (h) to
- 21 read as follows:
- (c) The secretary of state may prescribe additional
- 23 standards for voting systems consistent with this title. The
- 24 standards may apply to particular kinds of voting systems, to

- 1 particular elements comprising a voting system, including
- 2 operation procedures, or to voting systems generally, provided that
- 3 the county or political subdivision providing the voting system:
- 4 (1) can demonstrate a specific inability to comply
- 5 with a provision of this code; and
- 6 (2) has applied to and received written approval from
- 7 the secretary of state for waiver from this code specifying:
- 8 (A) the election and election date to be
- 9 affected; and
- 10 (B) the specific inability to comply with a
- 11 provision of this code.
- 12 (f) Waivers issued by the secretary of state under
- 13 Subsection (c) must be addressed and requested separately by a
- 14 county or political subdivision for each election.
- 15 <u>(g) The secretary of state shall attach the approval order</u>
- 16 to the approval request for each applicable election under
- 17 Subsection (c) and retain it permanently on file.
- 18 (h) Waivers granted under Subsection (c) must be posted on
- 19 the Internet website of the requesting county or political
- 20 subdivision not less than 60 days before the first day of the early
- 21 voting period and must remain posted during the affected election.
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 62.008(b), Election Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
