1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-19 AN ACT

relating to the numbering and signing of ballots by early voting 1-20 1-21 clerks and deputy early voting clerks. 1-22

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 85.0311, Election Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 85.0311. <u>DEPUTY</u> EARLY VOTING CLERK TO SIGN BALLOTS. (a) The <u>deputy</u> early voting clerk's <u>signature or</u> initials shall be placed on the back of each ballot to be used at the polling place where the deputy early voting clerk accepts voters voting by personal appearance.

(b) The <u>deputy</u> early voting clerk <u>at a polling place</u> shall enter the <u>signature or</u> initials <u>of the deputy early voting clerk</u> on each ballot [or a deputy early voting clerk shall stamp a facsimile of the initials on each ballot].

(c) The signing of ballots under this section need not be completed before the polls open, but an unsigned ballot may not be made available for selection by a voter.

(d) The duties of a deputy early voting clerk and the placement of a signature or initials required by this section may not be satisfied using automation of any type.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
