8	OMISSION OF CARE IN CERTAIN GROUP HOMES. (a) For purposes of this
9	section, "group home" means an establishment that provides, in one
10	or more buildings, lodging to three or more residents who are
11	unrelated by blood or marriage to the owner of the establishment and
12	that provides those residents with community meals, light
13	housework, meal preparation, transportation, grocery shopping,
14	money management, laundry services, or assistance with
15	self-administration of medication but does not provide them with
16	personal care services as defined by Section 247.002, Health and
17	Safety Code. The term does not include an establishment described
18	by Section 260.002, Health and Safety Code.
19	(b) A person commits an offense if the person:
20	(1) has reasonable cause to believe that a resident of
21	a group home has suffered bodily injury due to assault, neglect, or
22	an omission in care; and
23	(2) fails to report that fact to law enforcement or the

Department of Family and Protective Services.
