## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to limitations on public health directives issued during a
3	state of disaster or outbreak of a communicable disease.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 418.0165 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 418.0165. PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTIVES. During a state of
8	disaster declared by the governor, if the governor issues a public
9	health directive as the governor determines necessary to address
10	the disaster, the directive must not be more stringent than any
11	public health directive for undocumented immigrants issued by
12	United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
13	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 81, Health and Safety
14	Code, is amended by adding Section 81.016 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 81.016. PUBLIC HEALTH DIRECTIVES. If the department
16	or a health authority issues a public health directive under this
17	chapter as the department or health authority determines necessary
18	to address an outbreak of a communicable disease or public health
19	disaster, the directive may not be more stringent than any public
20	health directive for undocumented immigrants issued by United
21	States Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
22	SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
23	a directive issued on or after the effective date of this Act.
24	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect

immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
