14	SECTION 2. Section 418.016, Government Code, is amended by
15	adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
16	(i) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) and except as provided
17	by this subsection, the governor may not suspend a provision of a
18	statute, an order, or a rule under this section if the provision,
19	order, or rule is related to the qualifications or procedures for
20	early voting by mail and voting by mail. Upon declaration of state
21	of disaster, the governor may suspend Section 86.006(a-1), Election
22	Code, only for the purpose of allowing a voter registered to vote at

an address located in a disaster area to deliver a marked ballot

voted under Section 86.006(a-1) to the early voting clerk's office

- 4 (j) the presiding officer of the governing body of a
- 5 political subdivision may not suspend a provision of a statute, an

- 7 is related to the qualifications or procedures for early voting by
- 8 mail and voting by mail.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
