## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishing a system for the sharing of information
- 3 regarding cyber attacks or other cybersecurity incidents occurring
- 4 in schools in this state.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 11.175, Education Code,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11.175. SCHOOL [DISTRICT] CYBERSECURITY.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 11.175, Education Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsections (g), (h), and (i) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (e) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 13 [The district's cybersecurity coordinator] shall report to the
- 14 agency or, if applicable, the entity that administers the system
- 15 established under Subsection (g) any cyber attack or other
- 16 cybersecurity incident against the school district's or
- 17 <u>open-enrollment charter school's</u> [<u>district</u>] cyberinfrastructure
- 18 that constitutes a breach of system security as soon as practicable
- 19 after the discovery of the attack or incident.
- 20 (g) The agency, in coordination with the Department of
- 21 Information Resources, shall establish and maintain a system to
- 22 coordinate the anonymous sharing of information concerning cyber
- 23 attacks or other cybersecurity incidents between participating
- 24 schools and the state. The system must:

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- 1 (1) include each report made under Subsection (e);
- 2 (2) provide for reports made under Subsection (e) to
- 3 be shared between participating schools in as close to real time as
- 4 possible; and
- 5 (3) preserve a reporting school's anonymity by
- 6 preventing the disclosure through the system of the name of the
- 7 <u>school at which an attack or incident occurred.</u>
- 8 (h) In establishing the system under Subsection (g), the
- 9 agency may contract with a qualified third party to administer the
- 10 system.
- 11 <u>(i)</u> The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 12 implement this section.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
