## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to recommendations made by the Parks and Wildlife Department and intervention by the Parks and Wildlife Department in 3 matters regarding certain permits. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 12.024, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 12.024. WATER PERMIT RESPONSIBILITIES. (a) The Texas 8 Commission on Environmental Quality [Department of Water 9 Resources] shall furnish to the department a copy of all permit 10 11 applications to store, take, or divert water. 12 (b) The department shall make recommendations to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the Texas [Department of] 13 14 Water Development Board [Resources] to protect fish and wildlife resources, including permit conditions, mitigation, and schedules 15 of flow or releases. In a proceeding for an individual water right 16 governed by environmental flow standards, the department may not 17 make a recommendation for a schedule of flow or releases that is in 18 conflict with the applicable standards. 19 Notwithstanding Section 5.115(b), Water Code, the [The] 20 (c) 21 department: 22 (1) shall be, on its request, granted a hearing or made 23 a full party in any hearing on an application for a permit to store, take, or divert water that is subject to notice and opportunity for 24

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1 hearing; and 2 (2) may request a hearing and full party status on a permit or authorization under review by the Texas Commission on 3 Environmental Quality that: 4 5 (A) is subject to notice and opportunity for 6 hearing; and 7 (B) may adversely affect property or wildlife 8 resources managed by the department. 9 SECTION 2. Section 5.115(b), Water Code, is amended to read as follows: 10 (b) At the time an application for a permit or license under 11 this filed with the executive 12 code is director and is administratively complete, the commission shall give notice of the 13 14 application to any person who may be affected by the granting of the 15 permit or license. A state agency that receives notice under this subsection may submit comments to the commission in response to the 16 17 notice but, except as expressly authorized by other law, may not contest the issuance of a permit or license by the commission. For 18 the purposes of this subsection, "state agency" does not include a 19 river authority. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
