- 7 (b) The commission shall conduct a study to identify
- 8 potential improvements to training provided to 9-1-1 emergency
- 9 service call takers and dispatchers.
- 10 (c) In conducting the study, the commission shall consider:
- 11 (1) the effectiveness of current training provided to
- 12 9-1-1 emergency service call takers and dispatchers on
- 13 communicating accurate information to law enforcement officers;
- 14 and
- 15 (2) potential improvements to the training to ensure
- 16 9-1-1 emergency service call takers and dispatchers are accurately
- 17 identifying and communicating whether a suspect is armed or
- 18 dangerous.
- 19 (d) In conducting the study, the commission may collaborate
- 20 with law enforcement agencies, community representatives, and
- 21 other interested parties.
- (e) Not later than September 1, 2022, the commission shall
- 23 prepare and submit to the legislature a written report containing
- 24 the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative or

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
