## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the conveyance of certain real property by certain
3	navigation districts.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 60, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 60.0381 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 60.0381. CONVEYANCE OF LAND BY CERTAIN NAVIGATION
8	DISTRICTS. (a) This section applies only to:
9	(1) a district that controls a ship channel or
10	waterway that is the subject of a project that has been authorized
11	or modified by the United States Congress in the Water Resources
12	Development Act of 2016 (Pub. L. No. 114-322, Title I, 130 Stat.
13	1632) or the Water Resources Development Act of 2020 (Pub. L. No.
14	116-260, Div. AA, 134 Stat. 2615); and
15	(2) a lease entered into before the effective date of
16	the Act enacting this section.
17	(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including
18	Section 5007.004, Special District Local Laws Code, to the extent
19	that a district has entered into a surface lease with an original
20	term of at least 20 years, the district may sell the land,
21	improvements, easements, and any other interests in the real
22	property or any part of the real property to the surface lease
23	counterparty according to this section. The land, improvements,
24	easements, and any other interests in real property may be conveyed

1	by the district to the surface lease counterparty, without
2	complying with the notice and bidding or other requirements of
3	Sections 60.040-60.042. The sale must be:
4	(1) approved by the port commission;
5	(2) executed by the chair of the port commission;
6	(3) attested by the executive director of the
7	district; and
8	(4) made for an amount that is not less than the
9	reasonable market value of the land, improvements paid for by the
10	district, easements, or other interest in real property, as
11	applicable, at the time of contracting for the sale.
12	(c) Money received from the sale of real property as
13	described by this section in excess of the sum of the reasonable
14	market value of the property and the amount of rent due for the
15	unexpired term of the surface lease may be used only for the purpose
16	of a project that has been authorized or modified by the United
17	States Congress in the Water Resources Development Act of 2016
18	(Pub. L. No. 114-322, Title I, 130 Stat. 1632) or the Water
19	Resources Development Act of 2020 (Pub. L. No. 116-260, Div. AA, 134
20	<u>Stat. 2615).</u>
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
25	Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
