- (b) A school district may apply to the commissioner to 15

- 4 Sec. 32.323. RULES. The commissioner may adopt rules as
- 5 <u>necessary to implement this subchapter.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
