18	SECTION 3. Section 501.052, Transportation Code, is amended
19	by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
20	follows:
21	(e) An applicant aggrieved by the determination under
22	Subsection (d) may appeal only to the county or district court of
23	the county of the applicant's residence. An applicant must file an
24	appeal not later than the fifth day after <u>receipt</u> [the date] of the

1 assessor-collector's determination. The judge shall try the 2 appeal in the manner of other civil cases. All rights and 3 immunities granted in the trial of a civil case are available to the 4 interested parties. If the department's action is not sustained, 5 the department shall promptly issue a title for the vehicle.

6 (f) A person may not apply for a hearing under this section
7 if the department's decision under Section 501.051 is related to a
8 title for a salvage motor vehicle or a nonrepairable motor vehicle,
9 as defined by Section 501.091.

SECTION 4. Section 501.053, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

12 (f) A person may not obtain a title under this section for a 13 salvage motor vehicle or a nonrepairable motor vehicle, as defined 14 by Section 501.091.
