## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 501.051, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (d) The department shall place a hold on processing a title
- 7 application for a motor vehicle if the department receives a
- 8 request for a hold accompanied by evidence of a lawsuit regarding
- 9 ownership of or a lien interest in the motor vehicle. The hold
- 10 shall continue until the lawsuit is concluded or the party
- 11 requesting the hold requests the hold be removed.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 501.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 14 follows:
- 15 (e) An applicant aggrieved by the determination under
- 16 Subsection (d) may appeal only to the county or district court of
- 17 the county of the applicant's residence. An applicant must file an
- 18 appeal not later than the fifth day after  $\underline{\text{receipt}}$  [the date] of the
- 19 assessor-collector's determination. The judge shall try the
- 20 appeal in the manner of other civil cases. All rights and
- 21 immunities granted in the trial of a civil case are available to the
- 22 interested parties. If the department's action is not sustained,
- 23 the department shall promptly issue a title for the vehicle.
- 24 (f) A person may not apply for a hearing under this section

- 1 if the department's decision under Section 501.051 is related to a
- 2 title for a salvage motor vehicle or a nonrepairable motor vehicle,
- 3 as defined by Section 501.091.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 501.053, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 6 (f) A person may not obtain a title under this section for a
- 7 salvage motor vehicle or a nonrepairable motor vehicle, as defined
- 8 by Section 501.091.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
