5	SECTION 1. Section 2254.101(2), Government Code, is amended

7	(2) "Contingent fee contract" means a contract for
8	legal services under which the amount or the payment of the fee for
9	the services is contingent in whole or in part on the outcome of the
10	matter for which the services were obtained. The term includes an
11	amendment to a contract for legal services described by this
12	subdivision if the amendment:
13	(A) changes the scope of representation; or
14	(B) may result in:
15	(i) the filing of an action; or
16	(ii) the amending of a petition in an
17	existing action.
18	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
19	a contract or contract amendment entered into on or after the
20	effective date of this Act.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
