2	relating to training requirements for certain individuals for
3	inclusion in the nurse aide registry.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 250.001, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivisions (6), (7), and (8) to read as follows:
7	(6) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
8	Commission.
9	(7) "Executive commissioner" means the executive

- 9 (7) "Executive commissioner" means the executive 10 commissioner of the commission.
- 11 (8) "Nurse aide training program" means a nurse aide
 12 training and competency evaluation program that:
- (A) is approved by the commission to train and
- 14 evaluate an individual's ability to work as a nurse aide in a
- 15 facility; and
- 16 (B) meets the requirements of Section
- 17 250.0035(a).
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 250.0035(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 (a) To be listed on the nurse aide registry, an applicant
- 21 must complete a <u>nurse aide</u> training program approved by the
- 22 <u>commission</u> [Department of Aging and Disability Services] that
- 23 includes:
- 24 (1) not less than 100 hours of course work as specified

- 1 by rule; and
- 2 (2) a competency evaluation on completion of the
- 3 training program.
- 4 SECTION 3. Chapter 250, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 250.00351 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 250.00351. WAIVER; TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN
- 7 INDIVIDUALS. (a) In this section, "temporary nurse aide" means an
- 8 individual who performs nurse aid services under a waiver issued by
- 9 the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services during the
- 10 coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic.
- 11 (b) The executive commissioner shall seek a waiver from the
- 12 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services that allows an
- 13 individual in accordance with this section to partly or wholly
- 14 satisfy the classroom training and clinical training hours required
- 15 for completion of a nurse aide training program with classroom and
- 16 <u>clinical hours completed as a temporary nurse aide at a nursing</u>
- 17 facility licensed under Chapter 242.
- 18 <u>(c) An individual who works as a temporary nurse aide may</u>
- 19 substitute:
- 20 (1) one hour of training accrued as a temporary nurse
- 21 aide at a nursing facility for one hour of required classroom
- 22 training through a nurse aide training program;
- 23 (2) two hours of work experience accrued as a
- 24 temporary nurse aide at a nursing facility for one hour of required
- 25 classroom training through a nurse aide training program; and
- 26 (3) one hour of work experience accrued as a temporary
- 27 nurse aide at a nursing facility for one hour of required clinical

- 1 training through a nurse aide training program.
- 2 (d) A nursing facility shall document the number of hours of
- 3 nurse aide training and work experience accrued by a temporary
- 4 nurse aide at the facility and provide the documentation to that
- 5 individual on request.
- 6 (e) A nurse aide training program shall accept a nursing
- 7 facility's documentation of the number of hours of training and
- 8 work experience accrued by a temporary nurse aide at the facility
- 9 and apply the documented hours toward the classroom training and
- 10 clinical training hours required by the training program in
- 11 <u>accordance with Subsection (c).</u>
- 12 (f) If an individual does not accrue a sufficient number of
- 13 training or work experience hours as a temporary nurse aide under
- 14 <u>Subsection (c) to satisfy the total number of classroom training</u>
- 15 and clinical training hours required to successfully complete the
- 16 nurse aide training program, the individual must complete the
- 17 remaining number of required hours through a nurse aide training
- 18 program.
- 19 (g) If an individual satisfies the total number of classroom
- 20 training and clinical training hours prescribed by Section
- 21 250.0035(a)(1) through training and work experience as a temporary
- 22 <u>nurse aide under Subsection (c) and any training and clinical hours</u>
- 23 completed under a nurse aide training program, a nurse aide
- 24 training program shall allow the individual to sit for the
- 25 competency evaluation required by Section 250.0035(a)(2). The
- 26 commission shall list in the nurse aide registry under Section
- 27 250.0035 each individual who passes the evaluation.

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1 (h) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to

2 <u>implement this section</u>.

- 3 SECTION 4. As soon as possible after the effective date of
- 4 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 5 Services Commission shall apply for and actively pursue from the
- 6 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services or another appropriate
- 7 federal agency the waiver as required by Section 250.00351, Health
- 8 and Safety Code, as added by this Act. The Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission may delay implementing this Act until the
- 10 waiver applied for under that section is granted.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
