- 2 relating to a temporary exemption from sales and use taxes for

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.357 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.357. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT; TEMPORARY
- 8 EXEMPTION. (a) In this section, "personal protective equipment"
- 9 means specialized clothing or equipment worn by a person:
- 10 (1) to protect the person against potential infectious
- 11 contaminants in the environment; or
- 12 (2) to interfere with the transmission of particles
- 13 <u>originating from the nose or mouth of the person.</u>
- 14 (b) The sale or use of personal protective equipment is
- 15 exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter.
- 16 (c) The comptroller may adopt rules to implement and
- 17 administer this section.
- 18 (d) This section expires January 1, 2022.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 20 affect taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 21 law in effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in
- 22 effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those
- 23 taxes.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2021, if it

- 1 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 2 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 3 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- 4 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
