14	is preparing the student for licensure as a licensed vocational
15	nurse; and
16	(2) participating in a clinical program at a facility
17	licensed under this chapter.
18	Sec. 242.953. SERVICES PROVIDED BY CERTAIN VOCATIONAL
19	NURSING STUDENTS. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, services
20	that are provided by a student to whom this subchapter applies in a
21	facility licensed under this chapter and authorized by a contract
22	or other arrangement with the facility are allowed at all times in
23	this state, including during a declared state of disaster.
24	(b) A facility licensed under this chapter may:

2	policies regarding health screenings or the use of personal
3	protective equipment; and
4	(2) condition the student's provision of services on
5	compliance with the facility's policies described by Subdivision
