3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 551.0025 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 551.0025. REQUIREMENTS FOR OPEN MEETING WITH
7	RESTRICTED PUBLIC ACCESS. (a) This section applies only to an open
8	meeting of a governmental body where public access to any open
9	portion of the meeting is limited or restricted.
10	(b) The requirements prescribed by this section are in
11	addition to other requirements of law applicable to an open
12	meeting. This section prevails to the extent of a conflict with
13	another provision of law.
14	(c) A governmental body that holds a meeting to which this
15	section applies shall:
16	(1) broadcast audio and video of all open portions of
17	the meeting live over the Internet and provide a link to the
18	broadcast in the notice of the meeting; or
19	(2) allow members of the public to listen to live audio
20	of all open portions of the meeting by telephone, provide a
21	toll-free telephone number for that purpose, and include the
22	toll-free telephone number in the notice of the meeting.
23	(d) If a governmental body makes an audio and video
24	recording of the open portions of a meeting under Subsection

1 (c)(3), the governmental body shall: 2 (e) If a governmental body holds a meeting to which this 3 section applies and at which members of the public are allowed to address the body, including a meeting to which Section 551.007 4 5 applies, the governmental body: 6 (1) shall allow members of the public to address the 7 body by telephone; 8 (2) may allow members of the public to address the body 9 over the Internet; and 10 (3) shall provide in the notice of the meeting a toll-free telephone number and, if applicable, an Internet link for 11 the purposes of Subdivisions (1) and (2). 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 13
