A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Lake Houston Dredging and Maintenance District; providing the authority to issue bonds; 3 providing authority to impose assessments and fees. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subtitle L, Title 6, Special District Local Laws 6 7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 9602 to read as follows: CHAPTER 9602. LAKE HOUSTON DREDGING AND MAINTENANCE DISTRICT 8 9 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS Sec. 9602.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 10 11 (1) "Board" means the board of directors of the 12 district. (2) "Director" means a member of the board of 13 directors of the district. 14 (3) "District" means the Lake Houston Dredging and 15 16 Maintenance District. Sec. 9602.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a 17 conservation and reclamation district created under and essential 18 to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas 19 Constitution. 20 21 Sec. 9602.0103. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) The district is created to serve a public use and benefit. 22 23 (b) All land and other property in the boundaries of the district will benefit from the works and projects accomplished by 24

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S.B. No. 1892 the district under the powers conferred by Section 59, Article XVI, 1 2 Texas Constitution. Sec. 9602.0104. DISTRICT TERRITORY. Unless the district 3 territory has been modified under Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water 4 5 Code, or other law, the boundaries of the district are coextensive with the boundaries of Harris County. 6 7 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS 8 Sec. 9602.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is governed by a board of directors appointed as follows: 9 10 (1) three directors appointed by the Harris County 11 Commissioners Court; 12 (2) three directors appointed by the city council of 13 the City of Houston; and 14 (3) the board's presiding officer, appointed jointly 15 by the county judge of Harris County and the mayor of the City of Houston. 16 17 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms. SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 18 Sec. 9602.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. Except as 19 provided by this chapter, the district has the powers and duties 20 applicable to a district under Chapter 49, Water Code. 21 Sec. 9602.0302. SPECIFIC POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) In this 22 section, "dredging and maintenance operations" includes the 23 24 removal of: (1) sediment and debris from under the water; and 25 26 (2) floating debris. (b) The district shall perform dredging and maintenance 27

1	operations on Lake Houston. The district may form interlocal
2	agreements with political subdivisions, corporate entities, or
3	other persons to perform dredging and maintenance operations on
4	Lake Houston.
5	(c) The district may seek from any source a grant of money,
6	equipment, or another resource to assist the district's dredging
7	and maintenance operations.
8	Sec. 9602.0303. LIMITATION ON POWERS. The district may
9	<u>not:</u>
10	(1) finance, develop, or maintain a recreational
11	facility under Subchapter N, Chapter 49, Water Code;
12	(2) exercise the power of eminent domain; or
13	(3) perform the same function as another conservation
14	and reclamation district whose territory overlaps with the
15	territory of the district.
16	SUBCHAPTER D. FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
17	Sec. 9602.0401. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE REVENUE BONDS. (a) The
18	district may issue bonds payable from and secured by district
19	revenue to carry out any power conferred by this chapter. The bonds
20	must be authorized by a board resolution.
21	(b) The bonds must be issued in the manner and under the
22	terms of the resolution authorizing the issuance of the bonds.
23	Sec. 9602.0402. PROHIBITION ON TAXATION. The district may
24	not impose an ad valorem tax.
25	SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2022, the Harris
26	County Commissioners Court, the city council of the City of
27	Houston, the county judge of Harris County, and the mayor of the

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City of Houston shall appoint the initial members of the board of
the Lake Houston Dredging and Maintenance District as required by
Section 9602.0201, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by
this Act.

5 (b) At the first meeting of the board of directors of the 6 Lake Houston Dredging and Maintenance District, the directors shall 7 draw lots to determine which four directors serve a term of four 8 years and which three directors serve a term of two years.

9 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 10 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 11 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 12 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 13 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 14 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 15 Government Code.

16 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 17 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 18 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 19 (c) its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 20 lieutenant governor, and the speaker 21 of the house of representatives within the required time. 22

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
