A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a Texas Medical Board complaint for a violation

3 described by Section 22.011(b)(12), Penal Code.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 154.051, Occupations Code, is amended as 6 follows by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1):
- 7 (d) The board may not consider or act on a complaint 8 involving care provided more than seven years before the date on 9 which the complaint is received by the board unless the care was 10 provided to a minor or the care involves a complaint under 11 Subsection (d-1). If the care was provided to a minor, the board
- 12 may not consider or act on a complaint involving the care after the
- 13 later of:
- 14 (1) the date the minor is 21 years of age; or
- 15 (2) the seventh anniversary of the date of the care.
- 16 <u>(d-1)</u> The board may not consider or act on a complaint
- 17 involving an alleged violation of Section 22.011(b)(12), Penal
- 18 Code, that occurred more than seven years before the date on which
- 19 the complaint is received by the board or more than 2 years from the
- 20 date the complainant knew or should have known of the facts giving
- 21 rise to the complaint, whichever is later.
- 22 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 23 complaint under Chapter 154, Occupations Code, initiated on or
- 24 after the effective date of this Act.
