5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 31.005, Election Code, is

8	SECTION 2. Section 31.005, Election Code, is amended by
9	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
10	follows:
11	(b) <u>The secretary of state may order</u> [If the secretary
12	determines that] a person performing official functions in the
13	administration of any part of the electoral processes to correct
14	offending conduct if the secretary determines that the person is
15	exercising the powers vested in that person in a manner that <u>:</u>
16	(1) impedes the free exercise of a citizen's voting
17	rights <u>; or</u>
18	(2) unless acting under an order of a court of
19	competent jurisdiction, delays or cancels an election that the
20	person does not have specific statutory authority to delay or
21	cancel.
22	<u>(c)</u> [, the secretary may order the person to correct the
23	offending conduct.] If <u>a</u> [the] person described by Subsection (b)
24	fails to comply with an order from the secretary of state under this

1 <u>section</u>, the secretary may seek enforcement of the order by a 2 temporary restraining order or a writ of injunction or mandamus 3 obtained through the attorney general.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
