relating to the authority of the Texas Department of Transportation to provide road services on federal military property.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
is amended by adding Section 201.1056 to read as follows:

Sec. 201.1056. AGREEMENTS FOR SERVICES ON FEDERAL MILITARY PROPERTY. (a) The department may enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Defense or another federal entity to allow the department to assist with the provision of road maintenance, improvement, relocation, or extension services for military installations.

(b) State funds may not be used to provide services under an

agreement entered into under this section.

(c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a) (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the department may not into an agreement under this section if payment for the services provided under the agreement would be made from funds provided to the state for public roads under Title 23, United States Code.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
