- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9243 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9243. PROHIBITION ON LEGACY PREFERENCES AND OTHER
- 9 CONSIDERATIONS IN ADMISSIONS. An institution of higher education
- 10 may not discriminate against, or give preferential treatment to, an
- 11 applicant for admission to the institution or to any college or
- 12 other educational program of the institution on the basis of:
- (1) a donation made or promised to the institution by
- 14 any person; or
- 15 (2) whether any relative or family member of the
- 16 applicant previously attended or supported the institution in any
- 17 <u>manner.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 51.805(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (c) A general academic teaching institution may review
- 21 other factors in making an admissions decision, subject to Section
- 22 51.9243.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
