7	In this section, "hyperemesis gravidarum" means a disorder that
8	causes a woman to experience extreme, persistent nausea and
9	vomiting during pregnancy that may lead to dehydration, weight
10	loss, or electrolyte imbalance.
11	(b) The commission shall develop and implement a five-year
12	strategic plan to improve the diagnosis and treatment of and raise
13	public awareness of hyperemesis gravidarum. Not later than
14	September 1 of the last state fiscal year in each five-year period,
15	the commission shall develop a new strategic plan for the next five
16	state fiscal years that begins with the following state fiscal
17	year.
18	(c) The strategic plan must provide strategies to:
19	(1) increase awareness among state-administered
20	program providers who may serve women at risk of or experiencing
21	hyperemesis gravidarum about the prevalence and effects of
22	hyperemesis gravidarum on outcomes for women and children;
23	(2) establish a referral network of community-based
24	health care providers and support services addressing hyperemesis

2	(3) increase women's access to formal and informal
3	peer support services, including access to certified peer
4	specialists who have successfully completed additional training
5	related to hyperemesis gravidarum;
6	(4) raise public awareness of hyperemesis gravidarum;

8	(5) leverage sources of funding to support existing
9	community-based hyperemesis gravidarum screening, referral,
10	treatment, and support services.
11	(d) The commission shall coordinate with the department and
12	the statewide health coordinating council in the development of the
13	strategic plan.
14	(e) The commission, in consultation with the department and
15	the statewide health coordinating council, shall annually review
16	the strategic plan and update the plan as necessary.
17	SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2022, the Health and
18	Human Services Commission shall develop the initial strategic plan
19	required by Section 32.047, Health and Safety Code, as added by this
20	Act.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
