A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the reduction of school district property taxes as a
- 3 result of the school facilities allotment.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 46.009, Education Code,
- 6 and Subsection (d) is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec.46.009. REDUCTION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY TAXES AS
- 8 RESULT [PAYMENT] OF SCHOOL FACILITY ALLOTMENT [FACILITIES
- 9 ALLOTMENTS].
- 10 (a) For each school year, the commissioner shall determine
- 11 the amount of money to which each school district is entitled under
- 12 this subchapter.
- 13 (b) If the amount appropriated for purposes of this
- 14 subchapter for a year is less than the total amount determined under
- 15 Subsection (a) for that year, the commissioner shall:
- 16 (1) transfer from the Foundation School Program to the
- 17 instructional facilities program the amount by which the total
- 18 amount determined under Subsection (a) exceeds the amount
- 19 appropriated; and
- 20 (2) reduce each district's foundation school fund
- 21 allocations in the manner provided by Section 42.253(h).
- (c) Warrants for payments under this subchapter shall be
- 23 approved and transmitted to school district treasurers or
- 24 depositories in the same manner as warrants for payments under

- 1 Chapter 42.
- 2 (d) As soon as practicable after September 1 of each year,
- 3 the commissioner shall distribute to each school district the
- 4 amount of state assistance under this subchapter to which the
- 5 commissioner has determined the district is entitled for the school
- 6 year. The district shall deposit the money in the interest and
- 7 sinking fund for the bonds for which the assistance is received. and
- 8 The district shall adopt $\frac{1}{4}$ and reduce the tax rate for purposes of
- 9 debt service that takes into account the balance of the interest and
- 10 sinking fund.
- 11 (e) Section 42.258 applies to payments under this
- 12 subchapter.
- 13 (f) If a school district would have received a greater
- 14 amount under this subchapter for the applicable school year using
- 15 the adjusted value determined under Section 42.257, the
- 16 commissioner shall add the difference between the adjusted value
- 17 and the amount the district received under this subchapter to
- 18 subsequent distributions to the district under this subchapter.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
