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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle E, Students and Parents, Education
- 8 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 27 to read as follows:
- CHAPTER 27. LEARNING POD PROTECTION 9
- Sec. 27.001. TITLE. This Chapter shall be known as The 10
- 11 Learning Pod Protection Act.
- Sec. 27.002. PURPOSE. This Chapter is necessary to ensure 12
- 13 that parents that choose to voluntarily associate to advance the
- primary or secondary education of their children in the state shall 14
- 15 not be subject to local restriction or regulation.
- Sec. 27.003. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 16
- 17 "Parent" means the parent or guardian of any child under
- 18 18.
- (2) "Learning Pod" means a voluntary association of parents 19
- choosing to group their children together at various times or 20
- places to participate in or enhance their primary or secondary 21
- 22 academic programming. Payment for any services provided to the
- children participating in the Learning Pod by the parents does not 23
- 24 exempt the grouping from this definition.

- 1 (3) "Operation of a Learning Pod" means all the parents of
- 2 the children participating in the Learning Pod and any other
- 3 individuals assisting those parents while engaged in any actions
- 4 taken to organize, facilitate or operate the Learning Pod, and any
- 5 facility, home or other structure utilized by the Learning Pod.
- 6 (4) "Primary or Secondary Education" means any learning
- 7 mode or system for a student to participate in primary or secondary
- 8 <u>academic</u>, athletic or other educational programming , including in
- 9 a Learning Pod, in grades pre-kindergarten through twelve.
- 10 Sec. 27.004. LEARNING POD REGULATORY EXEMPTIONS AND
- 11 PROTECTIONS. (a) Any Learning Pod shall be exempt,
- 12 notwithstanding any other, statute to the contrary, from the
- 13 following local government ordinances, rules, regulations,
- 14 policies, guidelines, or any other local regulatory provisions:
- 15 <u>(1) all local requirements including</u>, but not limited to
- 16 staff ratios, certifications, background checks, physical
- 17 accommodations, or other rules, regulations, guidelines, policies
- 18 or provisions;
- 19 (2) all local requirements related to the operation of a
- 20 day-care, child-care center, or at home daycare adopted under Human
- 21 Resources Code Chapter 42 or other law, including, but not limited
- 22 to locally required staff certifications, background checks,
- 23 physical accommodations or other rules, guidelines, or provisions;
- 24 (3) any local requirements related to building or fire codes
- 25 applicable to educational or child-care facilities;
- 26 (4) any other local, ordinance, rule, regulation, policy,
- 27 or guideline which would not be applicable to any group, building or

- 1 <u>facility but for the operation or presence of a Learning Pod.</u>
- 2 (b) No school district or other local government employee,
- 3 contractor or agent shall initiate or conduct any site inspection
- 4 or other investigation or visit, that would not have been initiated
- 5 or made but for the operation or presence of a Learning Pod.
- 6 (c) No school district or other local government employee,
- 7 contractor or agent shall initiate or conduct any site inspection
- 8 or other investigation or visit, that would not have been initiated
- 9 or made but for the operation or presence of a Learning Pod, on the
- 10 basis of any provision of federal code, rule, guideline, or any
- 11 other federal authority.
- 12 (d) No school district shall take or fail to take any action
- 13 or in any manner discriminate against or otherwise distinguish any
- 14 student or parent on the basis of participation in a Learning Pod.
- 15 (e) No school district or other local government employee,
- 16 contractor or agent shall require that any Learning Pod be in any
- 17 manner required to register or otherwise report its existence or
- 18 anything related to the operation of a Learning Pod.
- 19 (f) This section does not in any way alter or affect the
- 20 rights of parents to choose a home school setting for their
- 21 children, nor does it alter the regulation of any day-care center,
- 22 child-care center, or home-day care center related to any
- 23 operations or other matters not directly related to the operation
- 24 of a Learning Pod.
- 25 SECTION 2. The provisions of this Act are severable. If any
- 26 part of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, that
- 27 declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

- 1 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 2 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all members
- 3 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 4 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 5 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
