## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the requirements for a request for the revision of a 3 charter for an open-enrollment charter school.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 12.1101, Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 12.1101. NOTIFICATION OF CHARTER APPLICATION [OR 8 ESTABLISHMENT OF CAMPUS]. The commissioner by rule shall adopt a 9 procedure for providing notice to the following persons on receipt 10 by the commissioner of an application for a charter for an 11 open-enrollment charter school under Section 12.110 [or of notice 12 of the establishment of a campus as authorized under Section 13 <u>12.101(b=4)</u>]:

(1) the superintendent and the board of trustees of each school district from which the proposed open-enrollment charter school or campus is likely to draw students, as determined by the commissioner; and

18 (2) each member of the legislature that represents the
19 geographic area to be served by the proposed school or campus, as
20 determined by the commissioner.

21 SECTION 2. Section 12.114, Education Code, is amended to 22 read as follows:

23 Sec. 12.114. REVISION. (a) A revision of a charter of an 24 open-enrollment charter school <u>that is not an expansion revision</u>

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may be made only with the approval of the commissioner. <u>An</u>
 <u>expansion revision</u>, as defined by commissioner rule, may be made
 only in the manner provided by this section.

4 (b) Not more than once <u>during each biennium</u> [each year], an
5 open-enrollment charter school may request approval <u>of an expansion</u>
6 <u>amendment to:</u>

7 <u>(1) increase</u> [to revise] the maximum <u>allowable</u> student 8 enrollment described by the school's charter;

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(2) add a new campus or site;

10 (3) extend the grade levels described by the school's 11 charter; or

12 (4) expand the geographic boundaries described by the
13 school's charter.

14 A [Not later than the 60th day after the date that a] (c) 15 charter holder shall submit [submits] to the commissioner a completed request for approval for an expansion amendment[, as 16 17 defined by commissioner rule, including a new school amendment,] that identifies the zip code of any new campus or site and each 18 19 school district from which the charter school intends to enroll additional students and that estimates, in the manner provided by 20 commissioner rule, the additional cost to the state. The 21 commissioner shall publicly post the request for approval for an 22 expansion amendment not later than the 10th business day after the 23 24 date the charter holder submits the request.

(d) The commissioner shall thoroughly review a request for
 approval for an expansion amendment and, for each expansion
 amendment the commissioner proposes to approve, report to the State

2	(1) whether during the five years preceding the date
3	of the request the charter holder and open-enrollment charter
4	school have complied with every financial, governing, educational,
5	and operational standard adopted by the commissioner and specify in
6	detail each element of noncompliance;
7	(2) whether the open-enrollment charter school serves
8	the state average of students eligible to receive services under
9	Subchapter A, Chapter 29, or students of limited English
10	proficiency and whether each campus of the charter school serves
11	and is staffed to serve a percentage of those students proportional
12	to each school district campus within a three-mile radius of the
13	campus;
14	(3) the potential revenue loss for each affected
15	school district for the next 10 years under the proposed expansion;
16	and
17	(4) the additional estimated cost to the state for the
18	next 10 years under the proposed expansion amendment.
19	(e) Unless, before the 90th day after the date on which the
20	State Board of Education receives the notice from the commissioner,
21	a majority of the members of the board present and voting vote
22	against the expansion amendment, the commissioner's proposal to
23	approve the expansion amendment takes effect.
24	(f) The commissioner shall include in the agency's budget
25	request submitted to the Legislative Budget Board and the budget
26	division of the governor's office a specific item that details the
27	additional cost to the state, as estimated under Subsection (d)(4),

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## 1 for each approved expansion amendment.

2 (g) The [the] commissioner shall provide to the charter
3 holder written notice of approval or disapproval of <u>an</u> [the]
4 amendment <u>requested under this section</u>.

5 (h) [(d)] A charter holder may submit a request for approval 6 for an expansion amendment up to 18 months before the date on which 7 the expansion will be effective. A request for approval of an 8 expansion amendment does not obligate the charter holder to 9 complete the proposed expansion.

SECTION 3. Sections 12.101(b-4) and (b-10), Education Code, are repealed.

12 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 13 a request for approval of a revision to the charter of an 14 open-enrollment charter school submitted on or after the effective 15 date of this Act.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
