4	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 31, Election Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 31.125 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 31.125. VOTER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS CONFINED IN JAIL.
7	(a) The secretary of state, the authority in charge of the jail in

- 8 each county, and the early voting clerk of each county shall take
  9 appropriate action to:
- 10 <u>(1) inform each qualified voter confined in jail of</u>
  11 the voter's right to vote; and
- 12 (2) provide the qualified voter an opportunity to 13 vote.
- 14 (b) The authority in charge of the jail shall allow a person
- 15 who is qualified to vote and confined in jail access to a voter
- 16 registrar or deputy voter registrar for the purpose of submitting
- 17 an application to register to vote.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
