8	SYSTEMS AFTER PURCHASE OR ACQUISITION. (a) A person who files an
9	application described by Section 13.301(a) for the purchase or
10	acquisition of a water or sewer system may request that the
11	regulatory authority with original jurisdiction over the rates for
12	water or sewer service provided by the person to the customers of
13	the system authorize the person to charge initial rates for the
14	service that are:
15	(1) shown in a tariff filed with a regulatory
16	authority by the person for another water or sewer system; and
17	(2) in force for the other water or sewer system on the
18	date the application described by Section 13.301(a) is filed.
19	(b) The regulatory authority may not require a person who
20	makes a request under Subsection (a) to initiate a new rate
21	proceeding to establish the initial rates for service the person
22	will provide to the customers of the purchased or acquired system.
23	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
24	to a purchase or acquisition of a water or sewer system the

application for which is filed under Section 13.301(a), Water Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. A purchase or acquisition of a water or sewer system the application for which is filed under Section 13.301(a), Water Code, before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
