A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the designation of centers of excellence for the management and treatment of placenta accreta spectrum disorder. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subchapter G to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER G. CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE FOR MANAGEMENT AND TREATMENT 7 8 OF PLACENTA ACCRETA SPECTRUM DISORDER 9 Sec. 32.201. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "placenta accreta spectrum disorder" includes placenta accreta, placenta 10 increta, and placenta percreta. 11 12 Sec. 32.202. DESIGNATION OF CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE. (a) The department, in consultation with the Texas Maternal Mortality and 13 14 Morbidity Review Committee established under Chapter 34, shall designate as centers of excellence for the management and treatment 15 16 of placenta accreta spectrum disorder one or more health care entities or programs in this state, including any institution or 17 community hospital with the appropriate resources and personnel, as 18 determined by the department and the review committee. 19 (b) The executive commissioner, in consultation with the 20 21 department and the Texas Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Review Committee, shall adopt rules necessary for a health care entity or 22 23 program in this state to be designated as a center of excellence for management and treatment of placenta accreta spectrum disorder. 24

1 Sec. 32.203. SUBCOMMITTEE. (a) The department, in 2 consultation with the Texas Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Review 3 Committee, shall appoint a subcommittee of the review committee to advise the executive commissioner on the adoption of rules under 4 5 Section 32.202. As part of the subcommittee's duties under this subsection, the subcommittee specifically shall advise the 6 7 executive commissioner on the criteria necessary for a health care 8 entity or program in this state to be awarded a designation under this subchapter. 9 10 (b) The subcommittee must consist of individuals with expertise in the management and treatment of placenta accreta 11 12 spectrum disorder. A majority of the members of the subcommittee must practice in those areas in a health profession in this state. 13 14 The subcommittee may include national and international experts. 15 Sec. 32.204. PRIORITY CONSIDERATIONS FOR CENTER DESIGNATIONS. The rules adopted under Section 32.202 must 16 17 prioritize awarding a designation under this subchapter to a health 18 care entity or program that: 19 (1) offers specialized management services for placenta accreta spectrum disorder through a multi-specialty 20 clinical program and an associated hospital that provides advanced 21 22 neonatal and maternal care in accordance with the hospital's level 23 of care designation assigned under Section 241.182; 24 (2) demonstrates a significant commitment to research 25 in and advancing the field of care for placenta accreta spectrum disorder; 26 27 (3) fosters telemedicine, referral, and transport

1 relationships with rural hospitals in this state; and 2 (4) integrates an advanced placenta accreta spectrum disorder management program with a program that provides 3 appropriate long-term monitoring and follow-up care for patients. 4 Sec. 32.205. REQUIREMENTS FOR CENTER DESIGNATION. The 5 rules adopted under Section 32.202 must ensure that a health care 6 7 entity or program in this state that receives a center of excellence 8 designation under this subchapter: 9 (1) provides or is affiliated with a hospital that provides advanced neonatal and maternal care in accordance with the 10 hospital's level of care designation assigned under Section 11 12 241.182; (2) establishes minimum criteria for medical, 13 nursing, ancillary, and support staff, in addition to any other 14 15 criteria required under Section 32.202; 16 (3) measures short-term and long-term patient 17 diagnostic and therapeutic outcomes; and (4) submits to the department annual reports 18 19 containing aggregate data on short-term and long-term diagnostic and therapeutic outcomes as requested or required by the department 20 and makes those reports available to the public on the entity's or 21 22 program's Internet website. SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2021, the 23 (a) 24 Department of State Health Services, in consultation with the Texas Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Review Committee established 25 26 under Chapter 34, Health and Safety Code, shall appoint members to 27 the subcommittee as required by Section 32.203, Health and Safety

2 (b) Not later than September 1, 2022, the executive 3 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall 4 adopt rules as required by Section 32.202, Health and Safety Code, 5 as added by this Act.

6 (c) Not later than September 1, 2022, the Department of 7 State Health Services shall begin awarding designations of centers 8 of excellence as required by Subchapter G, Chapter 32, Health and 9 Safety Code, as added by this Act.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
