- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6002.052(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Under rules adopted under Section 6002.051, the
- 8 department may create specialized licenses or registration
- 9 certificates for an organization or individual engaged in the
- 10 business of planning, certifying, leasing, selling, servicing,
- 11 installing, monitoring, or maintaining fire alarm or fire detection
- 12 devices or systems. The rules must establish appropriate training
- 13 and qualification standards and continuing education requirements
- 14 for each kind of license and certificate.
- SECTION 2. Section 6002.159(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (b) If the commissioner certifies continuing education
- 18 programs under this section, the commissioner by rule shall require
- 19 <u>license holders to participate</u> [Participation] in the [continuing
- 20 education] programs [is voluntary].
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a license issued or renewed on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act. A license issued or renewed before the effective date of
- 24 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the

- 1 effective date of this  $\mathsf{Act}$ , and that law is continued in effect for
- 2 that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
