- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 298E.103(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 9 with respect to an intergovernmental transfer of funds described by
- 10 Subsection (c)(1) made by a district, any funds received by the
- 11 state, district, or other entity as a result of that transfer may
- 12 not be used by the state, district, or any other entity to:
- 13 (1) expand Medicaid eligibility under the Patient
- 14 Protection and Affordable Care Act (Pub. L. No. 111-148) as amended
- 15 by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Pub. L.
- 16 No. 111-152); or
- 17 (2) fund the nonfederal share of payments to hospitals
- 18 available through [the Medicaid disproportionate share hospital
- 19 program or] the delivery system reform incentive payment program.
- 20 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 21 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 22 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 23 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 24 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

- 1 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
