S.B. No. 2058

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to individual graduation committee qualification
3 requirements for certain students.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 28.0258, Education Code, is amended by
6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) and (h-1) to
7 read as follows:

8 (a) This section applies ~~only~~ to an 11th or 12th grade
9 student who has failed to comply with the end-of-course assessment
10 instrument performance requirements under Section 39.025 for not
11 more than two courses.

12 (a-1) This section applies to all 12th grade students for
13 the 2020-2021, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023 school years without the
14 performance requirements under Subsection (a). This subsection
15 expires September 1, 2023.

16 (h-1) For the 2020-2021, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023 school
17 years, an individual graduation committee may determine that a
18 student is qualified to graduate without considering performance on
19 any end-of-course assessment instruments administered under
20 Section 39.023, Education Code. This subsection expires September
21 1, 2023.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
