## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of the Mental Illness and
3	Intellectual or Developmental Disability Advisory Council.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 7, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 535 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 535. MENTAL ILLNESS AND INTELLECTUAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL
8	DISABILITY ADVISORY COUNCIL
9	Sec. 535.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "advisory
10	council" means the Mental Illness and Intellectual or Developmental
11	Disability Advisory Council established under this chapter.
12	Sec. 535.002. ESTABLISHMENT OF ADVISORY COUNCIL. The
13	Mental Illness and Intellectual or Developmental Disability
14	Advisory Council is established to advise the commission and the
15	legislature on best practices in providing care to individuals with
16	co-occurring mental illness and intellectual or developmental
17	disabilities.
18	Sec. 535.003. APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERS. The
19	advisory council is composed of the following members:
20	(1) one member appointed by the commissioner of
21	education;
22	(2) one member appointed by the executive director of
23	the Texas Department of Criminal Justice;
24	(3) one member of the Governor's Committee on People

1 with Disabilities appointed by the governor; 2 (4) any other individual considered necessary by the 3 governor, appointed by the governor; and 4 (5) the following members appointed by the executive 5 commissioner: 6 (A) one member representing an advocacy 7 organization in this state supporting individuals with 8 intellectual or developmental disabilities; 9 (B) one member representing an advocacy 10 organization in this state supporting individuals experiencing mental illness; 11 12 (C) one member representing an advocacy organization in this state supporting individuals involved in the 13 14 criminal justice system; 15 (D) one member representing a local mental health 16 authority; 17 (E) one member representing a local intellectual and developmental disability authority; 18 19 (F) one parent or family member of a person with co-occurring mental illness and intellectual or developmental 20 disabilities; 21 (G) one member who is a person with an 22 intellectual or developmental disability who has personally 23

(H) one member who is a licensed health care

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experienced mental illness;

- 1 <u>(I) one member who</u> is a licensed social worker,
- 2 as defined by Section 505.002, Occupations Code;
- 3 (J) one member who is a teacher certified in
- 4 special education under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code;
- 5 (K) one member who is a representative of a
- 6 public institution of higher education in this state that is a
- 7 member of one of the University Centers for Excellence in
- 8 Developmental Disabilities Education, Research, and Service; and
- 9 <u>(L) one member who has experience researching the</u>
- 10 mental health needs of individuals with an intellectual or
- 11 developmental disability.
- 12 Sec. 535.004. TERMS; VACANCY. (a) The advisory council
- 13 shall select a presiding officer from among the advisory council
- 14 members.
- 15 <u>(b) Members of the advisory council shall serve two-year</u>
- 16 <u>terms.</u>
- 17 (c) A vacancy on the advisory council shall be filled in the
- 18 same manner as the original appointment.
- 19 (d) A member appointed to fill a vacancy holds the office
- 20 for the unexpired portion of the term.
- 21 (e) Each member may be reappointed to serve on the advisory
- 22 council by the appropriate appointing authority as provided by
- 23 Section 535.003.
- Sec. 535.005. MEETINGS; QUORUM. (a) The advisory council
- 25 shall meet at times and locations as determined by the presiding
- 26 officer or by a majority of the members of the advisory council.
- 27 (b) A majority of the members of the advisory council

- 1 constitute a quorum.
- 2 Sec. 535.006. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT. The commission shall
- 3 provide administrative support to the advisory council.
- 4 Sec. 535.007. ANNUAL REPORT. Not later than December 1 of
- 5 each year, the advisory council shall prepare and submit to the
- 6 governor, lieutenant governor, legislature, commission, and other
- 7 relevant state agencies or stakeholders a written report that
- 8 <u>includes recommendations on ensuring that comprehensive and</u>
- 9 integrated mental health and intellectual or developmental
- 10 disability services in this state are available and provided using
- 11 <u>a person-centered approach in institutional, public, and private</u>
- 12 settings.
- 13 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the governor, the commissioner of education, the
- 15 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission,
- 16 and the executive director of the Texas Department of Criminal
- 17 Justice shall appoint members to the Mental Illness and
- 18 Intellectual or Developmental Disability Advisory Council, as
- 19 required by Chapter 535, Health and Safety Code, as added by this
- 20 Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
