4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is
5	amended by adding Sections 38.0721 and 38.0722 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 38.0721. EXCLUSION OF WATER FACILITIES FROM ROLLING
7	BLACKOUT. The commission by rule shall require each electric
8	utility, municipally owned utility, and electric cooperative to
9	exclude any circuits that provide power to a facility necessary to
10	provide water to wholesale customers from participation in the
11	utility's or cooperative's attempt to shed load in response to a
12	rolling blackout initiated by an independent organization
13	certified under Section 39.151 or another reliability council or
14	power pool in which the utility or cooperative operates.
15	Sec. 38.0722. WATER TREATMENT GRANTS. (a) The commission
16	shall establish a program to provide grants of state money
17	appropriated for that purpose to facilities necessary to provide
18	water to wholesale customers for the purpose of purchasing of
19	generators to provide a backup power supply for water treatment
20	during a power outage.
21	(b) The commission by rule shall adopt criteria for
22	determining which facilities should receive grants under this
23	section. The criteria must prioritize facilities in:
24	(1) areas with a high frequency or duration of power

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- 1 outages relative to other areas of the state; and
- 2 (2) economically distressed areas, as defined by
- 3 <u>Section 15.001, Water Code.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
