## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the composition of the Public Utility Commission of 3 Texas. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.051(a), Utilities Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The commission is composed of five [<del>three</del>] commissioners appointed by the governor with the advice and consent 8 9 of the senate, with: (1) three commissioners of the political party whose 10 candidate for governor received the most votes in the most recent 11 gubernatorial election; and 12 13 (2) two commissioners of the political party whose 14 candidate for governor received the second most votes in the most recent gubernatorial election. 15 16 SECTION 2. The governor shall promptly appoint two commissioners to the Public Utility Commission of Texas in 17 accordance with Section 12.051, Utilities Code, as amended by this 18 Act. The governor shall designate one commissioner to a term that 19 expires September 1, 2025, and one commissioner to a term that 20 21 expires September 1, 2027. 22

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
