

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the requirements of entities that receive state funds

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Sec. 772.602. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

(1) "9-1-1 region" means the portion of a state planning region established under Chapter 391, Local Government Code, composed of counties and municipalities that on September 1, 2015, exclusively received 9-1-1 system services provided by a 9-1-1 system operated through a regional planning commission.

(2) "Board" means the board of managers of a district.

(3) "District" means a regional emergency communication district created under this subchapter.

(4) "Regional planning commission" means a commission or council of governments created under Chapter 391, Local Government Code, for a designated region.

SECTION 1. Chapter 772, Health and Safety Code, is amended by amending Section 772.610 to read as follows:

Sec. 772.610. AUDIT AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

(4) A district who receives state funds shall have a disaster plan in place on the occasion that a natural disaster occurs.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
