9	out of, or withdrawal from a school district, the district shall
10	provide to the student and the student's parent information
11	regarding the eligibility requirements for public assistance
12	<pre>programs, including:</pre>
13	(1) the medical assistance program under Chapter 32,
14	Human Resources Code;
15	(2) the child health plan program under Chapter 62,
16	Health and Safety Code; and
17	(3) the supplemental nutrition assistance program
18	under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code.

- (b) The agency, in coordination with the Health and Human

- 21 <u>districts a model form for the information required to be provided</u>
- 22 <u>under Subsection (a).</u>
- 23 <u>(c) In providing the information required under Subsection</u>
- 24 (a), the school district shall ensure that the student's parent

- 1 signs a form acknowledging receipt of the information.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2021-2022
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
