## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of certain counties to raise revenue for
3	low cost sterilizations for dogs and cats by imposing a refundable
4	fee for dogs and cats who are not sterilized and are adopted without
5	being sterilized prior to adoption.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Chapter 828, Health and Safety Code, is amended
8	by adding Section 828.015 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 828.015. FEE FOR DOGS AND CATS WHO ARE ADOPTED IN
10	CERTAIN COUNTIES.
11	(a) This section applies only to a county with a population
12	of more than 75,000:
13	(1) A county in which an animal shelter or releasing
14	agency is located may assess a refundable fee of not less than \$25
15	when a dog or cat is adopted by a new owner and the dog or cat is not
16	already sterilized at the time of adoption.
17	(b) The county where a dog or cat is adopted by an animal
18	shelter or a releasing agency may:
19	(1) transfer any revenue from any fees authorized by
20	Subsection (b) and not refunded to the adopter to the general
21	fund of the county; and
22	(2) use the revenue to subsidize sterilizations for
23	dogs and cats by:
24	(a) contracting with a 501(c)(3) organization that provides

spay/neuter services; or 1 2 (b) allocating the funds to an animal shelter or releasing 3 agency to hire veterinary staff to provide spay/neuter services; or (c) contracting with a 501(c)(3) organization that serves 4 5 low income residents in the county to distribute spay/neuter vouchers to be used at private veterinary clinics in the county. 6 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021. 11
