A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to disposition of motor vehicle registration fees 3 collected by a county assessor-collector. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 502.198(b) and (c), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) Each Tuesday, a county assessor-collector shall credit to the county road and bridge fund an amount equal to the net 8 collections made during the preceding week until the amount so 9 credited for the calendar year equals the total of: 10 \$200,000 [\$60,000]; and 11 (1)12 (2) \$600 [\$350] for each mile of county road maintained by the county, according to the most recent information 13 14 available from the department, not to exceed 500 miles. (c) After the credits to the county road and bridge fund 15 equal the total computed under Subsection (b), each Tuesday the 16 county assessor-collector shall: 17 (1) credit to the county road and bridge fund an amount 18 equal to 50 percent of the net collections made during the preceding 19 week, until the amount so credited for the calendar year equals 20 21 \$500,000 [\$125,000]; and 22 (2) send to the department an amount equal to 50 23 percent of those collections for deposit to the credit of the state 24 highway fund.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
