A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the election of members of the board of directors of the
- 3 Travis County Water Control and Improvement District No. 17.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 9017, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER C. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- 8 Sec. 9017.101. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
- 9 governed by a board of five directors.

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- 10 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms, with two or
- 11 three directors' terms expiring at the first meeting of the board
- 12 after the November election in even-numbered years and after the
- 13 board has canvassed the votes and the newly elected directors have
- 14 qualified for office and taken the constitutional oath.
- Sec. 9017.102. ELECTION DATE. The district shall hold an
- 16 election to elect the appropriate number of directors on the
- 17 uniform election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election Code,
- in November of each even-numbered year.
- 19 SECTION 2. A director of the board of the Travis County
- 20 Water Control and Improvement District No. 17 who is serving on the
- 21 day before the effective date of this Act shall serve until the
- 22 director's term expires. A director whose term expires in May 2022
- 23 shall continue to serve until the director's successor has
- 24 qualified for office and taken the constitutional oath following

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- 1 the directors' election held on November 8, 2022, in accordance
- 2 with Sections 9017.101 and 9017.102, Special District Local Laws
- 3 Code, as added by this Act. A director whose term expires in May
- 4 2024 shall continue to serve until the director's successor has
- 5 qualified for office and taken the constitutional oath following
- 6 the directors' election held on November 5, 2024.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 8 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 9 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 10 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 11 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 12 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 13 Government Code.
- 14 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 15 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 16 Environmental Quality.
- 17 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 18 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 19 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 20 representatives within the required time.
- 21 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 22 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 23 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 24 and accomplished.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

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- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
