- 20 (2) principal office is located, if the entity's

- 13 executed and acknowledged in the manner provided by Section 71.053
- 14 for a certificate filed under that section.
- SECTION 3. Section 71.104(b), Business & Commerce Code, as
- 16 added by this Act, applies only to a certificate filed on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act. A certificate filed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 19 date the certificate was filed, and the former law is continued in
- 20 effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
