The district is a 19 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, 20 21 Texas Constitution. Sec. 7904A.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION 22 23 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent 24

CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 3 7904A.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or 4 extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has 5 consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the 6 7 district and to the inclusion of land in the district. A mistake made in the 21 22 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process does not affect the district's: 23 24 organization, existence, or validity; (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes 25 26 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 27 interest on a bond;

The commission shall appoint as 6 7 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 8 petition. 9 Sec. 7904A.0203. DESIGNATED BOARD MEETING LOCATION. (a) The board shall designate a meeting place inside the district for 10 conducting the meetings of the board. The meeting place designated 11 12 may be a private residence or office, provided that, in the order designating the meeting place, the board declares the place where 13 the meeting is held to be a public place and invites the public to 14 15 attend any meeting of the board held in that place. (b) If the board establishes that no suitable place exists 16 17 for meeting inside the district, the board may designate a meeting place outside the district. The board shall give notice of the 18 19 location of a meeting place outside the district by: (1) filing a copy of the resolution designating the 20 location and a justification of why the meeting will not be held in 21 the district or within 10 miles of the boundary of the district, if 22 applicable, with the commission; and 23 24 (2) publishing notice of the location in a newspaper of general circulation in the district. 25 26 (c) If the board changes the location of a meeting place outside the district, the board shall give notice of the change in 27

1 the manner described by Subsection (b). 2 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES 3 Sec. 7904A.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 4 5 which the district is created. Sec. 7904A.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 6 7 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the 8 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 9 10 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. Sec. 7904A.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. 6	applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is

8	consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land
9	in the district.
10	SUBCHAPTER D. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
11	Sec. 7904A.0401. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
12	OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
13	payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
14	revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
15	combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
16	purpose.
17	Sec. 7904A.0402. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
18	issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
19	board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
20	direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all
21	or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
22	provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

24	issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations

THENCE, with said east line and said common league line, North 02 degrees 18 minutes 47 seconds West (call North 00 degrees 22 minutes 00 seconds East), a distance of 805.73 feet (call 804.58 feet) to a 1/2 inch iron pipe found at the common west corner of said 30.00 acre and aforesaid 57.34 acre tract;

7 THENCE, with the common line between said 30.00 acre and 57.34 acre 8 tracts, North 87 degrees 54 minutes 34 seconds East (call South 89 9 degrees 28 minutes 30 seconds East), a distance of 1,618.94 feet 10 (call 1,623.30 feet) to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 29.93 11 acres of land.

12 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 13 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 14 15 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 16 17 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. 18

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 22 (c) its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 23 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the 24 house of representatives within the required time. 25

26 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this27 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect

1 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 2 and accomplished.

3 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds 4 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 5 7904A, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of 6 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7904A.0306 to read as 7 follows:

8 <u>Sec. 7904A.0306. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may</u> 9 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

10 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a 11 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c), 12 Article I, Texas Constitution.

13 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
