5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Article 2.33 to read as follows:
7	Art. 2.33. DUTY TO REQUEST AND RENDER AID. (a) Except as
8	provided by Subsection (b), a peace officer who encounters an
9	injured person while discharging the officer's official duties
10	shall immediately and as necessary:
11	(1) request emergency medical services personnel to
12	provide the person with emergency medical services; and
13	(2) while waiting for emergency medical services
14	personnel to arrive, provide first aid or treatment to the person to
15	the extent of the officer's skill and training.
16	(b) The peace officer is not required to request emergency
17	medical services or provide first aid or treatment under Subsection
18	<u>(a) if:</u>
19	(1) making the request or providing the treatment
20	would expose the officer or another person to a risk of bodily
21	injury; or
22	(2) the officer is injured and physically unable to
23	make the request or provide the treatment.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
