- Art. 2.33. DUTY TO REQUEST AND RENDER AID. (a) Except as
- 8 provided by Subsection (b), a peace officer who encounters an
- 9 injured person while discharging the officer's official duties
- 10 <u>shall immediately and as necessary:</u>

for an injured person.

- 11 (1) request emergency medical services personnel to
- 12 provide the person with emergency medical services; and
- 13 (2) while waiting for emergency medical services
- 14 personnel to arrive, provide first aid or treatment to the person to
- 15 the extent of the officer's skill and training.
- 16 (b) The peace officer is not required to request emergency
- 17 medical services or provide first aid or treatment under Subsection
- 18 (a) if making the request or providing the treatment would expose
- 19 the officer or another person to a risk of bodily injury.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
