A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Uptown Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County; granting a limited power of eminent domain; 3 providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose 4 5 assessments, fees, and taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7909A to read as follows: 8 9 CHAPTER 7909A. UPTOWN MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF COLLIN 10 COUNTY 11 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 12 Sec. 7909A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: "Board" means the district's board of directors. 13 (1) (2) "Commission" means the <u>Texas</u> Commission on 14 15 Environmental Quality. 16 (3) "Director" means a board member. (4) "District" means the Uptown Municipal Utility 17 District No. 1 of Collin County. 18 Sec. 7909A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a 19 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, 20 21 Texas Constitution. Sec. 7909A.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION 22 23 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent 24

(a) The district 5 is governed by a board of five elected directors. 6 (b) Except as provided by Section 7909A.0202, directors 7 serve staggered four-year terms. 8 Sec. 7909A.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) The temporary board consists of: 9 10 (1) Caleb Lavey; (2) Cole Talley; 11 12 (3) Luke Brown; (4) Zack Schneider; and 13 14 (5) Ben Hangartner. (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of: 15 16 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under 17 Section 7909A.0103; or (2) the fourth anniversary of the effective date of 18 19 the Act enacting this chapter. (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under 20 Section 7909A.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have 21 expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or 22 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that 23 24 expire on the earlier of: 25 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under 26 Section 7909A.0103; or 27 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the

1 appointment or reappointment. 2 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a 3 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the 4 5 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as 6 7 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 8 petition. 9 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES Sec. 7909A.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district 10 has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 11 12 which the district is created. Sec. 7909A.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 13 14 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the 15 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 16 17 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. Sec. 7909A.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. 18 Under Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may 19 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, 20 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a 21 22 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid 23 24 of those roads. Sec. 7909A.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 25 26 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each 27

| 12 | ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all          |
| 13 | applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is       |
| 14 | adopted under Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that        |
| 15 | consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land |
| 16 | in the district.   |
| 17 | Sec. 7909A.0306. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district              |
| 18 | may be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:  |
| 19 | (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and                              |
| 20 | (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.                                |
| 21 | (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by              |
| 22 | division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and  |
| 23 | duties of the district.  |
| 24 | (c) A new district created by the division of the district           |

No. 2249 1 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of 2 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the 3 4 district. 5 (e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district before or after the date the board holds an election under Section 6 7 7909A.0103 to confirm the district's creation. 8 (f) An order dividing the district shall: 9 name each new district; 10 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the territory of each new district; 11 12 (3) appoint temporary directors for each new district; 13 and 14 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities 15 between the new districts. 16 (g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of 17 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order with the commission and record the order in the real property 18 19 records of each county in which the district is located. (h) Any new district created by the division of the district 20 shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by 21 Section 7909A.0103. If the voters of a new district do not confirm 22 the creation of the new district, the assets, obligations, 23 24 territory, and governance of the new district revert to the original district. 25 26 (i) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district granted under Section 27

1 7909A.0104 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new district created by the division of the district and to the 2 3 inclusion of land in the new district. 4 (j) Any new district created by the division of the district 5 must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue 6 7 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes. SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS 8 Sec. 7909A.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) 9 10 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other 11 obligations secured by: 12 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or (2) contract payments described 13 by Section 14 7909A.0403. 15 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 16 17 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes. 18 19 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a 20 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an 21 22 election held for that purpose. Sec. 7909A.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) 23 Ιf 24 authorized at an election held under Section 7909A.0401, the district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable 25 26 property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water 27 Code.

| 19 | Sec. 7909A.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district           |
| 20 | issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the     |
| 21 | board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing        |
| 22 | direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all |
| 23 | or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner   |
| 24 | provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.                  |
| 25 | Sec. 7909A.0503. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of             |
| 26 | issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations   |
| 27 | issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad      |

# 1 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the

2 real property in the district.

16 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 17 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 18 Environmental Quality.

19 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 20 governor, and the speaker 21 lieutenant of the house of representatives within the required time. 22

5 <u>Sec. 7909A.0307. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may</u> 6 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

7 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a
8 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c),
9 Article I, Texas Constitution.

10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
