- 4 the United States Semiquincentennial Commission is working

- 7 WHEREAS, Established by the Semiquincentennial Commission
- 8 Act of 2016, the United States Semiquincentennial Commission is a
- 9 federal commission that collaborates with affiliates at the local,
- 10 territorial, state, tribal, regional, national, and international
- 11 levels; the initiative strives to educate, engage, and unite
- 12 Americans throughout a commemorative period that ranges from 2020
- 13 to 2027, and its efforts will culminate in the Fourth of July events
- 14 of 2026; and
- WHEREAS, As of March 10, 2021, 11 states have established
- 16 organizations to highlight themselves in the 250th commemoration by
- 17 planning and implementing programs that honor the history and
- 18 culture of the United States, including public art displays, museum
- 19 exhibitions, and educational curriculums, and the commission
- 20 expects the widest participation to occur through state and local
- 21 projects like these; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Since the adoption of the Declaration of
- 23 Independence in 1776, Americans have treasured the rights to life,
- 24 liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, and Texas can pay tribute to

- 1 these important values by joining in the celebration of the United
- 2 States' 250th anniversary; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 4 hereby create the Texas America 250 Commission and work jointly
- 5 with the United States Semiquincentennial Commission to help
- 6 celebrate the semiquincentennial of the United States; and, be it
- 7 further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the commission will include any federal
- 9 designees residing in the state as well as a member or designee of
- 10 each of the following commissions and departments: the Office of
- 11 the Governor, Economic Development and Tourism; the Texas Parks and
- 12 Wildlife Commission; the State Board of Education; the Bullock
- 13 Texas State History Museum; the Texas State Library and Archives
- 14 Commission; and other related historical organizations; and, be it
- 15 further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the commission be funded solely through
- 17 donations and federal funds and that it be abolished on December 31,
- 18 2026.
