CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 968 has been adopted by the senate
- 2 and the house of representatives and is being prepared for
- 3 enrollment; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the senate be instructed to make the
- 8 following corrections to the enrolled version of Senate Bill
- 9 No. 968:
- 10 (1) In the SECTION of the bill amending the heading to
- 11 Subtitle D, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, immediately after
- 12 "DISASTERS", insert "AND EMERGENCIES".
- 13 (2) In the SECTION of the bill amending the heading to
- 14 Chapter 81, Health and Safety Code, immediately after "DISASTERS",
- 15 insert "; PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCIES".
- 16 (3) Strike the recital to the SECTION of the bill amending
- 17 Section 81.003(7), Health and Safety Code, and substitute the
- 18 following:
- 19 SECTION ____. Section 81.003, Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended by amending Subdivision (7) and adding Subdivision (7-a) to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (4) In the SECTION of the bill amending Section 81.003,
- 23 Health and Safety Code, immediately after amended Section
- 24 81.003(7), Health and Safety Code, insert the following:

- 1 (7-a) "Public health emergency" means a determination
- 2 by the commissioner, evidenced in an emergency order issued by the
- 3 commissioner, that there exists an immediate threat from a
- 4 communicable disease, health condition, or chemical, biological,
- 5 radiological, or electromagnetic exposure that:
- 6 (A) potentially poses a risk of death or severe
- 7 <u>illness or harm to the public; and</u>
- 8 <u>(B) potentially creates a substantial risk of</u>
- 9 harmful exposure to the public.
- 10 (5) In the SECTION of the bill adding Sections 81.0813,
- 11 81.0814, and 81.0815, Health and Safety Code, in the heading to
- 12 added Section 81.0813, Health and Safety Code, between "DISASTER"
- 13 and the underlined period, insert "OR ORDER PUBLIC HEALTH
- 14 EMERGENCY".
- 15 (6) In the SECTION of the bill adding Sections 81.0813,
- 16 81.0814, and 81.0815, Health and Safety Code, in added Section
- 17 81.0813(a), Health and Safety Code, in the first sentence of that
- 18 subsection, between "disaster" and "if", insert "or order a
- 19 statewide or regional public health emergency".
- 20 (7) In the SECTION of the bill adding Sections 81.0813,
- 21 81.0814, and 81.0815, Health and Safety Code, in added Section
- 22 81.0813, Health and Safety Code, strike Subsections (b), (c), (d),
- 23 and (e) of that section and substitute the following:
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a public health
- 25 disaster or public health emergency continues until the governor or
- 26 commissioner terminates the disaster or emergency on a finding
- 27 that:

Τ	(1) the threat or danger has passed; or
2	(2) the disaster or emergency has been managed to the
3	extent emergency conditions no longer exist.
4	(c) A public health disaster or public health emergency
5	expires on the 30th day after the date the disaster or emergency is
6	declared or ordered by the commissioner. A public health disaster
7	may only be renewed by the legislature or by the commissioner with
8	the approval of a designated legislative oversight board that has
9	been granted authority under a statute enacted by the legislature
10	to approve the renewal of a public health disaster declaration.
11	Each renewal period may not exceed 30 days.
12	(d) A declaration or order issued under this section must
13	<pre>include:</pre>
14	(1) a description of the nature of the disaster or
15	<pre>emergency;</pre>
16	(2) a designation of the area threatened by the
17	disaster or emergency;
18	(3) a description of the condition that created the
19	disaster or emergency; and
20	(4) if applicable:
21	(A) the reason for renewing the disaster or
22	emergency; or
23	(B) the reason for terminating the disaster or
24	emergency.
25	(e) A declaration or order issued under this section must be
26	disseminated promptly by means intended to bring its contents to
27	the public's attention. A statewide or regional declaration or

- 1 order shall be filed promptly with the office of the governor and
- 2 the secretary of state. A regional declaration or order shall be
- 3 filed with the county clerk or municipal secretary in each area to
- 4 which it applies, unless the circumstances attendant on the
- 5 disaster or emergency prevent or impede the filing.
- 6 (8) In the SECTION of the bill adding Sections 81.0813,
- 7 81.0814, and 81.0815, Health and Safety Code, in added Section
- 8 81.0814, Health and Safety Code, between "disaster" and the
- 9 underlined comma, insert "or ordering a public health emergency".
- 10 (9) Strike the SECTION of the bill repealing Sections
- 11 81.082(d) and (e), Health and Safety Code, and substitute the
- 12 following:
- SECTION _____. Section 81.082(e), Health and Safety Code, is
- 14 repealed.
